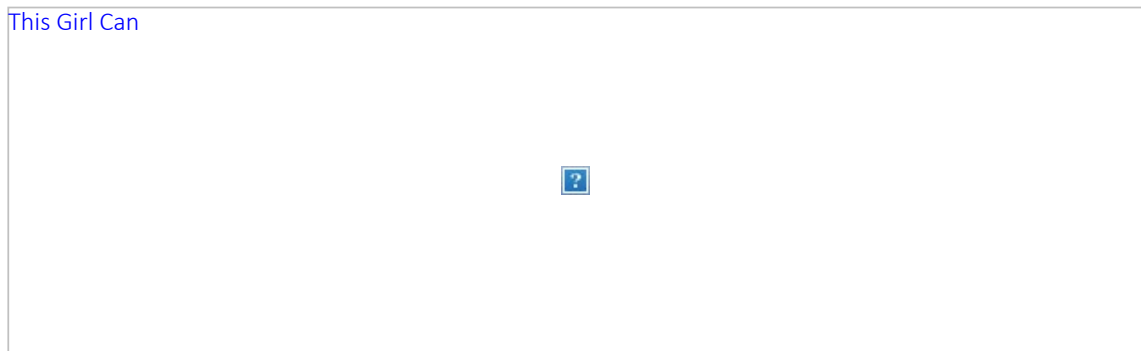
- *It is likely to prejudice the use of, or lead to the loss of use, of land being used as a playing field: or*
- *It is on land which has been*
  - *used as a playing field at any time in the 5 years before the making of the relevant application and which remains undeveloped; or*
  - *allocated for use as a playing field in a development plan or in proposals for such a plan or its alternation or replacement; or*
- *It involves the replacement of the grass surface of a playing pitch on a playing field with an artificial, man-made or composite surface.*

Procedurally, it is important that Sport England be formally consulted on this application as a matter of some urgency and, in accordance with the term of the Order referred to above, Sport England will respond within 21 days of receipt of such a consultation/notification, or in the case of an application for 'public service infrastructure development' within 18 days of receipt of such a consultation/notification.
