<p>I am writing this on behalf of my 81 year old father, who lives on the street, and is in ill health, but is seriously concerned by the proposals he has seen locally on lampposts. As he is not able to use technology, he has requested this is done for him. These are his concerns.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Darley is already not equipped to deal with the amount of cars and visitors, so it is incomprehensible that this proposal be allowed to add volumes of traffic, including HGVs, diggers, construction equipment and other associated vehicles.</li><li>2. Using Darley would seriously increase risk of serious injuries and fatalities to the elderly, vulnerable and young children in the area.</li><li>3. Darley and Ripley are seriously congested throughout the majority of days. With further vehicles, this would impact the ability of emergency services to access the roads.</li><li>4. Whilst I don't have first hand knowledge of the flooding or the Greenway, I am aware of several of my neighbours seeing this first hand and being concerned about this (I don't tend to wander too far down, due to age and health).</li><li>5. There were old mines in that area and I am unaware if these were backfilled, or made safe for construction purposes. This would need a full independent investigation, not the owners or council officials.</li></ol>
