<p>As a resident of Ripley Road I strongly object to the proposed plans. The objections of the coal board and Yorkshire water are obviously concerning but as a resident I can categorically state the main area of concern is the access and egress to the proposed site . Contrary to the Traffic and parking study Ripley and Darley road can not cope at present and safety is already a major concern , adding another 100 plus vehicles would be utter madness and would almost certainly result in accidents and injury if not death . This comment may seem extreme but it is a harsh reality probably not realised by none residents and planners. I certainly will not let my grandchildren play out if these plans go ahead. Morning traffic at school time is already queuing down Ripley and Darley to access Halifax road , adding the extra traffic to this would be very dangerous not to mention the pollution caused to the surrounding area .
