| <p>We object wholeheartedly to these proposed plans for the following reasons.</p> <p>1- The impact on highway safety. The amount of traffic, on this one road in and out, is bad enough already, then to add another potential 100 or more so cars/vans is unimaginable. There is not enough room for parking for the current residents, never mind adding to it. This will be most impacted in bad weather when the residents at the bottom start dumping their cars at the top of Darley Road and surrounding areas- Halifax Road- Ripley Road and making it even worse, as they cannot get to their normal parking because of the snow and ice. The speed that some drivers drive down here is ridiculous. Children and pets are at danger, with the speed and amount of traffic - again one way in and the same one way out. The road is not wide enough for 2 way traffic. You often have to wait for the oncoming traffic to come through and then you can go. When there is a call for the emergency services, there is nowhere for them to park, so they have no option than to block the road, so no one can get in or out while they deal with the emergency. Refuse collection is a nightmare. We have seen one or 2 accidents with the bin van. There is not enough room for them to manoeuvre round.</p> <p>The ONLY exit out of here, on to the main Halifax Road is extremely dangerous as it is, especially if you are trying to turn right. You cannot see because of parked cars one way and if the bus is in the bus stop you cannot see the other way either. That needs looking at urgently.</p> <p>2- Environment This will affect wildlife in the area and destroy the natural environment. The noise and disruption will increase and also pollution will rise, which will affect all our health. This whole thing will have a massive negative impact to all existing residents and surrounding areas.</p> | |
