<p>There are a number of issues with permitting this application.</p> <p>Firstly, the impact that a further 77 dwellings will add to the local roads. The area in question and the surrounding motorways are already too busy, particularly at peak times. The impact that this will have on the traffic, accidents and additional pollution in the area would be catastrophic. Please consider this from a town-planning perspective.</p> <p>Secondly, schools are already oversubscribed. School places are difficult to obtain as it is. As a teacher, I cannot stress enough the fact that our local classrooms are already fit to burst. A further 77 dwellings could realistically mean that another 150 children (approximately) could be competing for local school places.</p> <p>Furthermore, Kirklees as a council are struggling as it is to maintain our current towns and villages. There is not the time or money for this development.</p> <p>Finally, Kirklees desperately needs to cling on to its green spaces. The catastrophic impact that this would have environmentally should be enough in itself to decline this proposal. The impact to wildlife habitat; the increase in air and noise pollution; and the fact that 77 new-build dwellings will completely obliterate the beautiful views for the current residents are all reasons within themselves to object to this proposal.</p>
