<p>I have concerns about the Designated sites, important habitats or other biodiversity features response, what exactly will be impacted by this development? The past few years have really shown the importance of having these natural areas on our doorstep &amp; they helped locals mental health enormously during the pandemic, the loss of these areas would be unforgivable. I am also very concerned about the huge amount of traffic this will generate, the current exit onto Halifax Road from Primrose Lane is already dangerous due to the high wall on the Old Hall and the parking for the chip shop &amp; pub during the summer months, the other way out onto Bradford Road would send cars either down under the railway bridge which often has fly tipping underneath &amp; some people find it tight to go through so their preference would be Halifax Road though the lower hall estate which is very busy, with cars parked on kerbs &amp; children regularly play out on the street.
