<p>I object to the planning application for Primrose Lane ref.2023/91116. I fully support all of the comments on complaint ref.993066. The fields provide a continuous corridor between Quaker Lane and Denby Close where wildlife thrives. New housing would have a significant impact on the wildlife there and is unnecessary. Whilst recognising new housing is needed in the UK, the Spen area has been saturated recently to the extent that all social services are stretched to their limits. The roads in this area are already so congested that it is almost impossible to travel at peak times without being stuck in long queues of traffic. The idea to have access for 100 plus cars via Ripley/Darley road is both ridiculous and incredibly dangerous. I drive carefully but have had near misses with children playing on these roads. The narrow roads were not made to deal with the current amount of traffic, never mind doubling or trebling the current volume. Finally, any social issues described for Primrose Lane are vastly exaggerated. Many people use this lane regularly and safely at all times of the day. I would suggest having extra housing would only increase the possibility of social misbehaviour.</p>
