I agree and support all previous comments raised regarding this proposed development. This is a dead end cul de sac with very limited access. The hilly approach is a source of great danger throughout the winter months and increasingly throughout the year due to extreme weather conditions. Holmbridge is an over populated village with few amenities. All residents have to travel for basic necessities and fuel but there is very limited infrastructure in place ie public transport, good quality roads, parking amenities and shops. Residents are currently subjected to very lengthy powercuts, not a recent occurrence as it has been continually happening for many years. Schools in the area are limited and already full without the addition of a family housing development. Secondary education from the area entails further travel which requires more public transport which is very limited now and always has been ie hourly bus services that is if they turn up! There are no footpaths and there is no room for improvement on the local roads. The roads in the village are chaotic on all minor and main roads due to the volume, speed and parking of vehicles. The power supply to the area and sewage systems are under increasing pressure and seem to be failing current residents without an increase with this development. Very disappointing that a development for 16 houses received so much objection and appears to have been ignored and increased to 21 houses. A slap in the face for everyone!
