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Many local residents have commented on the potential instability of Dobb Top Road .

The photographs below may be of use to both Kirklees and Parish Councillors when considering this Application.

This photograph shows water currently percolating through the dry-stone retaining wall above Dobb Top Road , below the North-East corner of Site HS183:--.



The photograph below shows recent repairs to the retaining wall supporting Dobb Top Road , below Netherley House and above Bank Lane , Holmbridge :-



The recent landslides above Bank Lane may have been related to Spring and drainage water emanating at a Public Springwater Collection Point at the bottom of Bank Lane.

This is shown in the photograph below :--



Dobb Top Road has subsided by about 18 inches for about 10 yards down towards the Sculpture Lounge starting at a point about 20 yards East of Laithe Bank Drive.

This may have been caused by the construction of houses on Laithe Court or the removal of trees stabilising the embankment to the North of this section of Dobb Top Road.
