1. Increase in traffic, 16 houses, 2 cars each (maybe more), extra 64 vehicle's up and down per day not including deliveries (White vans, Amazon, Supermarket deliveries etc). 2. Very steep access, NEVER gritted, 40ft/12m drop where Bankfield joins Dobb Top Road, has a history of collisions where council have to repair the wall. 3. Laithe Bank, steep gradient (1:6 ?) NEVER gritted, cars plough into wall which has had damage before, falling to 40ft drop 4. Rural school route, mini bus route along Smithy Lane which is largely not paved, cars parked on blind corners, my husband has already notified the council via email on his concerns about speeding traffic. 5. This will add to congestion along with the proposed Water Street development (another 19 houses!!) on small, country roads and rural school routes. Already there is a significant amount of parked cars near the school and along Hinchcliffe Mill. 6. Increased traffic will make the 'rat run' of Woodhead Road even worse. Currently there are cars parked on each side of the road from Londis to the Pickled Pheasant pub, you have to bob and weave everyday to make your journey. 7. Visually unappealing, taking away from the beauty of the Peak National Park as this development will be visible from the link road, Woodhead Rd.
