We wish to object to the proposal of clay extraction etc. at Bromley Farm for the next 25 years (this is effectively for the rest of our lives) on the basis of Noise pollution..... The previous quarry workings were extremely noisy and it is now a relief that this noise has ceased. Most noise was caused by HGVs being loaded/unloaded and being driven on uneven road surfaces when empty. At least half of the traffic will fall into that category. Reversing warning sirens were a constant disturbance as was the noise associated with rock crushing. The proposed hours of working are excessively early and late in the day when noise pollution is more evident and disturbing. Light pollution... The proposed hours of working will, in the winter, require drivers to use headlights to navigate the route to and from the site. These headlights will most likely intrude on our property and be offensive. Increased traffic flow..... Traffic flow in the village is already a problem with many roads being too narrow for large HGVs to pass each other. Footpaths are often too narrow or none existent and pedestrians are at risk when large vehicles use these narrow roads. Air pollution..... The previous quarry often created dusty air which was blown across the village. These dust particles were deposited on our gardens, cars, washing and presumably within our lungs. As there will be little benefit to the employment prospects of the local population and no benefit at all from an aesthetic point of view, we request that the Council rejects this application.
