I wholeheartedly object to this application.

The local roads are already plagued with HGVs. Quarry traffic, Shepley Spring traffic and a host of others.

We understand that the destination of the products of this proposed quarry will be Crow Edge. The application seems to neatly avoid this - though it is stated in an attached document!

Nothing is stated in the traffic section of the application other than access to the Barnsley Rd. I can only assume therefore that the lorries will want to drive along Carr Hill Road to get to Crow Edge.

Carr Hill Road is already used as a rat run by both cars and a few HGVs looking to avoid the Sovereign crossroads junction. Speeding is a problem - currently ignored by the council.

For some reason HGVs are currently permitted to travel up the road, but not down - this does not stop them! Sometimes at excessive speed (both ways).

Extra HGVs - 120 movements per working day - 10 per hour - one every six minutes is a massive increase.

This will create pollution - atmospheric and noise. The possibility of vibration damage is present.

Carr Hill Road has no pavements for much of its length - the risks to pedestrians will be considerably raised. A good number of walkers use the road as well as residents.

A number of young families live on the road.

It is a very busy cycle route. We read regularly of cyclists killed by HGVs

This proposal will make living on our road extremely unpleasant and dangerous.

This application by Silkstone "Environmental" should be rejected.
