We wish to object to the application for quarrying at Bromley Farm. Our concerns are about the health and safety of the residents of Upper Cumberworth. In the years that we have lived here the traffic has already increased considerably, resulting in an increase in the noise and dust levels and the poor quality of the road surfaces none of which will not be helped by the massive increase in heavy vehicles in the area.
