I would like to register my objection to the granting of this planning application as a resident of the semi rural village of Upper Cumberworth living on Dearnfield which has a small back garden backing into the A635. The current density of traffic is bad enough with cars, large wagons and farm vehicles etc. There is no respite from the noise and traffic fumes and the granting of this application will certainly make our situation a whole lot worse. All the obvious hazards are plain to see:- noise pollution, air pollution ie. dust and fumes, reversing alarms at 7.30 a.m, fumes from the road and heavy plant equipment, disturbing sealed ground, therefore releasing gasses ie. methane. Whatever happened to caring for the environment? The current road speed on the A635 (40mph) is too fast for large vehicles to turn into and out of the dump site and possibly Carr Hill road. The area is very busy with school traffic, particularly the crossroad area in Upper Cumberworth. Finally, do the council really think it is reasonable to foist onto local residents this type of misery for the next 25 years, which would be detrimental to the village environment and may well prove damaging to the residents health and well being.
