Every driver avoids the Sovereign cross roads; with the current side roads becoming death traps as safety measures are refused as it would place extra burden on the Sovereign cross roads [and thankfully we haven't had a fatality yet, as that is what it would take]. It is practical to assume the movement to Crow Edge will be via Carr Hill Road. This is not a main road, but a busy residential area - with many families using the roadside [as not all pavement] to walk to school etc. Kirklees cannot keep ignoring the fact that investment needs to be made into making the Sovereign Cross roads more driver friendly and the footpaths safer for the residents.
