I live at 2 Park Lane in Upper Cumberworth, and there is some real concern in the village about a planning application which could lead to hundreds of extra lorries coming along Carr Hill Road. Carr Hill Road is very much a residential road, with many elderly people and young children living along it. There is also no footpath for large stretches of the road and it is used by walkers, cyclists and dog owners. But the implications of consent for the planning application to extract clay from Bromley Farm will mean a massive increase in lorries using this road as a “rat-run”. Lorries already use this road because bizarrely, there is a weight restriction for lorries coming down the road, but not for lorries going up the road. There is a tight corner (at the junction with Park Lane), where lorries already cut across onto the other carriageway. Then another dangerous corner 50 yards further up. If this planning application is allowed in its current format, then this will become a major danger to the public. This proposal is inviting an accident. If the council were to put a traffic light at the “Sovereign crossroads”, then all lorries - and any increased lorry traffic from this proposal – would be able to use that junction efficiently. Instead the lorries at the moment by-pass that junction by coming up Carr Hill Road, and this new proposal will exacerbate this serious hazard.
