Hi, There are several things I disagree with on this application. The entrance to the waste site is not quiet it gets very busy at times as I have had to wait as far back as the A635 to get in. Where are the lorries going? to the dangerous and congested Sovereign junction, which is a site of many accidents. Or to the rat run of Carr Hill Road which has also had many serious accidents. The Sovereign junction is always congested so either the lorries will use the rat run or force other vehicles onto Carr Hill Road. I am a walker and already find Carr Hill Road dangerous with cars and lorries exceeding the speed limit travelling within inches of me. A further problem on Carr Hill Road is the right angled bend at the junction with Park Lane, I have had 2 accidents with my car and a heavy goods vehicle due to the lorries cutting the corner onto the wrong side of the road.
