The existing road infrastructure cannot support this application. This applies to the roads in and out of Cumberworth, Crow Edge and beyond. Woodroyd Hill Lane is a prime example of this. On average there are 5 or 6 lorries travelling on this road per hour, in both directions. Twelve lorries through various companies hourly. Despite assurances from the transport and quarry companies these drive at speed, creating a daily risk as this is a route for horse riders, cyclists, pedestrians and children. The noise pollution, environmental pollution and threat to wildlife also need considering for the route beyond Cumberworth. There are no suitable speed restrictions or traffic calming measures in place, that would enhance safety for the existing daily challenges we already face, or the risk being created by the prospect of an additional 120 HGV's per day. What safety measures, alternative routes or traffic calming measures or actions are being considered, and what liaison is taking place with Barnsley planning department as the roads we live on and use fall between Kirklees and Barnsley.
