I object to this application for two main reasons. If there is any coal under Upper Cumberworth then that's where it should stay. No-one should be given permission to extract coal due to the current climate emergency. The burden of additional HGV traffic would have a massive adverse impact on our village. Noise, dust and mud are major concerns but the biggest issue is the safety implications of huge numbers of HGVs using roads on which serious safety concerns have already been formally raised. We already endure more than our fair share of HGV traffic arising from existing quarrying and haulage operations in the immediate area. Additional noise and air pollution would be unbearable for the most severely affected residents. In addition, I have no confidence whatsoever that the applicant will, in the future, have either the funds or the inclination to restore the landscape after quarrying operations as promised.
