I wish to object to the proposed quarrying activities at Bromley Farm for the following, the number of lorries required per day to remove the quarried material will have a huge impact on the conservation area of Upper Cumberworth and Upper Deane Woodlands in terms of noise pollution, which has a negative effect on people's quality of life, affecting their health and well being. Harmful air pollutants - fine particles generated by heavy vehicles emitted directly by the number of lorries suggested by the plans, are harmful to health and the environment. These air pollutants would also affect trees and the landscape impacting the rural character of the area. The Plan suggests working hours at the quarry are 7.00 am the noise disturbance created by the increased HGV's will disturb local residents, with potential harmful health consequences. This is a rural area the roads are extensively used by cyclists, ramblers, dog walkers and horse riders to access bridle ways, there are limited pavements and the increased traffic on the rural roads presents a real highway safety issue for people enjoying the local rural area, as well as local residents using local schools and shops. If 120 lorries a day use the the local Road network this will have a detrimental effect on the character of the area and impact house prices significantly for all properties in the vicinity. For the reasons stated above I believe the Council should refuse this application.
