I wish to object to the proposed development on the following grounds: 1. Noise. Quarrying and HGVs on local roads will be noisy and will affect this small rural village. 2. Environmental pollution. Clay dust blowing over the village/residential areas will be detrimental to the air quality. There will be disturbance of habitats, affecting a variety of wildlife that we are fortunate to enjoy. 3. Roads. 120 HGVs a day will damage the road surfaces which are already in a poor state of repair. There is the likelihood that the lorries will not stay on the main roads and will use Carr Hill Road as a short cut. This is a rural road with no footpath for much of its length so pedestrians will be at great risk from heavy lorries. Road surfaces will be coated in dust in summer and mud in winter making them hazardous for both cars and pedestrians.
