My Objection is based on the road traffic impact on a rural village. Carr Hill road which is residential, is already used as a rat run to avoid the Sovereign cross roads by a number of heavy goods vehicles from local business's and through traffic. This small rural residential road is not really suitable for much of the traffic which already use's it, as most off the road does not have a footpath for pedestrian use. I am aware that there has been a significant number of successful prosecutions on this road this year of vehicles traveling too close to pedestrians, which shows that there is already a road traffic safety issue . There is little doubt that all of these extra HGV's would use this route, placing horse's cyclist's and pedestrians at a much increased risk . Should Kirklees allow this application to proceed I believe that an enforceable restriction should be put in place that these HGV's stick to agreed designated route's, or face removal of permission. I feel restrictive signage would be of little deterrent and would never get policed. The inclusion of such a restriction would lesson the considerable impact that this application would have on the village. I also feel strongly that if allowed that the company contribute to a fund on an annual basis for the benefit of the community which will face obvious disruption.
