This application for 25 years of activity (a whole generation of local residents affected) impacts negatively on: - noise, disturbance and odour. Six days per week heavy equipment working in close proximity to homes, schools and busy commercial areas - impact on highway safety and traffic. It is ridiculous to state a tipper truck every six minutes will have no impact. The vehicles will be operating on busy roads with complex, congested and already hazardous junctions at Upper Cumberworth, the Sovereign and Denby Dale. The roads are also extensively used by cyclists and horse riders, with tipper trucks being a well-evidenced cause of fatal accidents to cyclists. No provision has been made to mitigate delays to residents and risks at any of the junctions. If new traffic lights or islands prove to be needed, it is grossly unfair this cost should fall to council tax payers. - effect on the character of an area. Quarrying works are currently minimal. This application appears to transform the area and it's surrounding villages and roads into a major industrial site for a generation. No attempt has been made to mitigate this impact
