The access road into quarry & dump it site is too narrow for large vehicles when road is already used for tip site cars in & out, Braithwaites wagons & dump site skip wagons already use this narrow road which is difficult when cars are queuing to enter. as already mentioned in previous letters poor access to A635 main road. If these wagons go via the Sovereign junction they have difficulty turning left up the A629 when it's wet as they can't get traction to set off. The junction x roads to turn right up Cumberworth lane has only room for one to turn at once, if one is coming the other way main road traffic will have to stop where there have been many accidents lately. The five lane ends junction has a tight lefthand turn from a blind corner onto Haddingley lane, I have seen many cars go through this junction without even stopping, more traffic will make it worse. Haddingley lane is single track past Gawthorpes corner on double bend, further along Haddingley lane towards the Victoria x roads is very narrow, this route passes a national cycle route, many horse riders & stables nearby, dog walkers etc. there are no pavements along this route. The Victoria x roads has had many accidents & is a sharp turn left for the wagons going on wrong side of road. There is a newish highway code ruling that states cyclists & horse riders should be passed with a minimum gap of 1.5 meters, these lanes are not wide enough for HGV'S of this type to pass safely. This route also suffers from low cloud & fog when it's raining. These narrow country lanes are not suitable for what is proposed.
