The route which will be used from the site to Crow Edge is unsuitable for the proposed number of HGV's. These country lanes are used by a large number of cyclists, walkers and horse riders, including children on ponies on a daily basis. Country lanes are supposed to be quieter, safer areas for the public to walk, cycle and ride. This will not be the case if HGV's are using that route 120 times a day. The volume and weight of traffic will cause significant damage to the roads at the tax payers expense. The risk of RTA's will dramatically increase especially around the Sovereign cross roads. This is already an accident blackspot and has been for a number of years, however the council continue to ignore local residents concerns.
