I wish to object to the proposed quarrying at Bromley Farm Quarry for the following reasons: Noise Pollution- quarry workings, rock crushing and HGVs being loaded/unloaded, reversing warning sirens, uneven road surfaces. Dust Pollution- clay and shale are known to be dusty. HGVs entering and leaving the site from/to A639 every 6 minutes will be detrimental to the air quality. Major impact on the Environment- Loss of agricultural land destroying animal, insect and plant habitats. Trees and hedges are important and part of our local character. Increased Traffic- hours indicated are 7am -6pm these hours are too long and will add considerably to the local traffic concerns already for Upper & Lower Cumberworth our roads are not built for so many HGVs. This type of development in a residential area is unwanted and undesirable and if Kirklees approve an open cast mine for shale, clay and associated coal then they are going against their own target of being Net Zero and Climate Ready.
