I am writing this objection as a concerned dog walker, wildlife enthusiast and amateur conservationist, who regularly walks in and around the area in question, and also as a grandmother who regularly childminds for her daughter at her home in Upper Cumberworth. My first concern is that, far from disturbing the existing land, it is continually highlighted that there is today a need for more diverse habitats, by creating, for example, more wildflower meadows for the pollinators and the whole ecosystem, planting more trees to help absorb carbon dioxide from the atmosphere to assist in combating global warming, leaving existing habitats undisturbed to aid diversity, and I therefore strongly object to the land in question being used for quarrying. It is far too valuable a resource for conservation. Secondly, trying to cross the road with a pushchair and/or dog is already difficult and stressful, without the increased burden of more HGV's, and the proposals do not seem in keeping with the location of the surrounding village which is, and is proud of being in, a rural location. Lastly, I fear the noise pollution will be incredibly intrusive and find the research done into this to not be fully representative of everyone this will impact on, especially as the hours of operation are incredibly long, especially the start times.
