I have reviewed all previous complainants objections and without re-writing all of them I am in full agreement with their issues raised, However I would like to raise the following comments:- Notification of the application to residents has been non-existent, which is an underhanded way of dealing with such a complex project. Another reason is in the 'Supporting information' document Miller Goodhall have submitted an Air Quality & Dust Assessment for Bromley Farm Quarry, at Grantham, this suggests that this document has been copied and pasted, so how accurate is this document? and why was it not assessed by the council before publication. I am also concerned with the figure of an HGV entering the site every 6 minutes, this would happen if they actually worked the hours that have been stated, yes the site machinery may be working these hours but in reality, due to the HGV's driving hours, these hours would not be worked by them, from experience the figure will be every 4 minutes, therefore traffic is going to be much more than stated. Lastly, as Lower Cumberworth residents we will be surrounded by HGV's, the council are already allowing articulated vehicles to use Cumberworth Lane via Denby to access a haulage yard in Coal Pit Lane and now the proposed A635 for tipper lorries, the infrastructure of the roads is not built for this type of traffic in a rural area.
