I object to the application on the grounds of impact on highway safety as a result of significantly increased HGV traffic into and out of an already busy tip entrance and increased levels of environmental pollution. Contrary to the statement in 5.3.5 of the summary that there will be no noticeable addition to traffic flows there is bound to be with an HGV movement every six minutes for 25 years as stated in the application. There is also a question of the route these vehicles will take to Crow Edge as the local road infrastructure is largely inadequate. The additional toxic pollution levels that the HGV movements will generate are not compatible with the Governments guideline that planning applications should support healthy lifestyles and seems at odds with KC own vision of the timescale to reach net zero C02 emissions. There seems to be no advantage whatsoever to the local community to mitigate the pollution and increased road safety hazard resulting from this application.
