Dear Sirs

I wish to object to the proposed quarrying activities at Bromley Farm Quarry.

This is a green belt and rural area and as such should not be used for heavy industry. It will severely impact the agricultural and natural environment of the area and have put a serious burden on local residents from quarrying, heavy traffic, fumes, dust and noise.

So many heavy vehicles moving for such long hours is unacceptable for this area. No allowance is made for retired residents, who do not wish to be awake at 7am every morning, or shift workers with constant noise all day. There is no consideration of screening noise and fumes from the junction of the quarry access with the Bromley tip road down to the A635 and no allowance for the constant drone of road sweepers attempting to clear the mess. This has been unsuccessful in the past with large amounts of mud causing hazardous conditions on both the access road and A635.

Traffic fumes and noise through the village will be horrendous and dangerous for both vehicles and pedestrians especially when crossing the access road, either at the bottom where pavement to Denny Dale crosses, on the public footpath next to site access or on roads where there are no footpaths such as Carr Hill or Sovereign junction.

I hope the council accepts that the problems caused are far in excess of any benefits to this area and refuse this application.
