Monday, 14 August 2023 Bromley Farm Quarry Application Number 2023/62/91280/EO I wish to object to the proposed quarrying activities at Bromley Farm Quarry for the following reasons: It will be detrimental to conservation within the local area by removing habitats and nesting sites such as hedges, trees and rough grazing. There are red listed ground nesting birds such as Merlins, curlews and quails living within the surrounding area. The increased road traffic will significantly increase the noise, pollution and accident risks within the region. The working hours span existing rush hours when congestion and accidents at local junctions are already problems. The most probable route will include Carr Hill, a narrow residential road, with very little footpath, much used by pedestrians, cyclists and horse riders. this will lead to safety risks. The obvious pollution risks are dust and noise, but there are also unknown risks due to the area having historical mining and infill sites. There seems to have been very little research into the potential level of risk .This will be carried from the site on the wheels and sides of the lorries. This will pollute the air, roads and verges then wash down into the local fields, as most of the drainage relies on water soaking into the verges or drains that flow directly into local fields and waterways.
