I strongly object against this application for the following reasons:

- 1) Increase in and around the Cumberworth area and Barnsley Road. This is already a heavily congested area with several bottlenecks. The volume of traffic into Bramley Farm will only add to more congestion especially when the waste site is in operation. The ingress road into this area is one lane and this could cause congestion onto the main road.
 - 2) An increase of slow moving traffic will increase the number of motorists taking risks which will increase the risk for other road users and pedestrians. There is a busy school in Cumberworth and an increase in traffic from 07:00a.m will be an accident waiting to happen!
 - 3) An increase in noise and air pollution. This area is quite windy and therefore there will be a high level of dust generated from the quarry.
 - 4) The hours of operation are excessive and uncalled for and not in keeping with a rural location.
 - 5) A 5 metre mound along Cumberworth Lane will be an eyesore and not in keeping with the rural area.
 - 6) There is a highly used public footpath from Cumberworth into Denby Dale. Pedestrians have to walk across the planned ingress and egress road. This is bad enough now with the waste disposal site never mind with an additional HGV every 6 minutes.
 - 7) There are no employment benefits to the local area.
 - 8) Risk of clay, shale and other waste on the public highways creating dust when in dry weather and a skid hazard in wet conditions. In addition we have very changeable weather conditions around this area from very wet, to ice, snow and high winds all which contribute to difficult road conditions.
 - 9) Cumberworth and the surrounding areas have a high volume of hikers, dog walkers and cyclists and an increase in the volume of traffic in this area contributes to a higher risk level.
 - 10) I would expect that a development like this will devalue property prices around the area.
 - 11) This development will ruin the landscape and damage wildlife and nature.
