The application should be refused as it will involve significant local and more general environmental damage and disruption, including dust, noise, noxious vehicle emissions and road traffic hazards. I have friends in the area and I also frequently drive/walk/cycle in the area. Despite reassuring comments made by the applicants' consultants, there will be a significantly adverse effect on traffic volumes and road safety, making conditions worse for other road users. The A635 is already a busy, dangerous, road, especially at the Sovereign Crossroads and near the Star public house. At busy times there are large tailbacks in the Sovereign. If the application is successful, despite many valid objections, is very important to stipulate that vehicles must not make use of Carr Hill Road. This is a long, mostly straight, 30mph residential road, which already carries far too much traffic (mostly exceeding the speed limit) with hazardous junctions at both ends. Additional traffic on this road must be prevented for the sake of road safety and the amenity/comfort of local residents. Kirklees should therefore stipulate that this road must not be used by site traffic.
