I object to the proposed quarrying activities at Bromley Farm Quarry for the following reasons: 25 Years of quarrying with increased HGV traffic volumes and associated pollution is surely contrary to the Net Zero strategic aim espoused by Kirklees council. Cumberworth is a semi rural residential and agricultural area, activity of this nature will quickly turn Cumberworth into an industrial area. Hopefully Kirklees will recognise this when applications for council tax adjustments are made by residents of the surrounding areas. The increase HGV traffic will be a significant danger to pedestrians, cyclists and horses especially on Carr Hill Road where there are no footpaths along the majority of the road. The crossroads at the Sovereign Public House are already dangerous - Increased HGV traffic will do little to improve this. As a result there is likely going to be an increase in HGV traffic using Carr Hill Road in both directions - something that is already happening and is not policed. The access road to the Recycle centre is not wide enough to cater for the proposed traffic volumes without causing traffic to back up in the Recycle centre itself and consequently onto Barnsley Road. Anyone can see that the only beneficiaries are Wavin and Kirklees council - there is nothing but detrimental impact to the local area and its residents should this application be approved
