I wish to object to the proposed quarrying activities at Bromley Farm Quarry for several reasons:- It will impact greatly on the already busy roads around the locality including the area I live which is Carr Green. Cars already park too close to the junction of Carr Green and Carr Hill Road. Most of the time there is double park making it extremely difficult to pull out of Carr Green safely and also for traffic to drive safely near this junction. Due to the parking around this junction lorries from the quarry could possibly find themselves unable to pass the parked cars safely causing traffic chaos with long queues and danger to children walking to school and local bus stops because the quarry intends to be in operation from early hours 07.00-18.00. Constant traffic around the area will cause the road surface to deteriorate more quickly and although the road has recently been resurfaced it wouldn't take long for it to be in a poor state as previously and as the residents are in a high council tax band it is unfair to have poor highways. There is also the possibility of increased noise pollution. 120 HGV lorry movements per day would be detrimental to the air quality of the area- there is a primary school close by. The Government's National Planning Policy Framework states that planning decisions need to "enable and support healthy lifestyles." Having increased traffic, combined with a 'dirty' industry being reintroduced to the area does not support this aim. It will be detrimental to the locality and to the conservation area of Upper Cumberworth and Upper Dearne Woodlands. It is a residential area and is unwanted locally. No-one wants open cast mining that adds to considerably to diesel emissions on the roads and promotes open cast mining. The restoration plans are inadequate. There should be an going restoration plan rather than waiting until the end of all excavations.
