The main problem with this application is that Wavin UK has their main processing site at Crow Edge, Sheffield, where the materials from Bromley farm will be processed into clay pipes. The Traffic Impact statement says 120 HGV's per day will use the site and the majority of these vehicles will go to the Crow Edge site. Although there are adequate main road between the two sites (the A635 and A616), it is very likely that HGV's will want to go the more direct route over the minor roads. There is no mention of the wider impacts on minor roads in the Traffic Impact statement, only the A635 is mentioned. These minor roads are used by horse riders on a daily basis. Any HGV's passing them could cause them to be startled and lead to an accident. The infrastructure of these minor roads is inadequate for regular use by HGV's. There must be an enforceable transport plan in place that prevents HGV's traveling between the Bromley farm site and Crow Edge site (and vice versa) unless they are using the main roads.
