The proposed quarry development would have a detrimental affect on our family and everyone who lives within Upper and Lower Cumberworth. The additional noise from vehicles/HGVs, products being evacuated and tipped and the additional vibrations created by machinery. Our view from our garden faces the Bromley Park site and this would severely cause additional unwanted noise. This is not what you expect when you purchase a house in a small rural village. The proposed development will create additional airborne dust and dirt which will have a negative effect on local residents properties, cars and it remains to be seen if our long term health will suffer in anyway from exposure to the dust. The suggested increased traffic flow around Upper and Lower Cumberworth, up Carr Hill Road and the Sovereign junction will put pedestrians at risk. There are no pavements up Car Hill road and the pavements up Cumberworth Lane are very narrow. The residents of Cumberworth do not want additional unwanted HGV/traffic driving through our village and the risk of increase accidents. The proposed development would have major impact on the natural environment. We need to protect the animals and wildlife that currently reside in the area.
