Traffic issues with over 120 wagons a day passing through Upper and Lower Cumberworth to get to the quarry the roads can not cope with the volume of traffic that are using them now. If the applicant thinks that a extra 120 wagons is not a issue then they have not researched the traffic volumes properly Local jobs being provided by this applicant the applicant stats that this quarry will only provide 3-4 jobs which brings no significant new jobs to the area The loss of agricultural land for the quarry to be made will have a impact on local wildlife in the area Dust pollution will be a issue again to local residents and the safety of the roads they are going to use Wavin wagons already use the small b roads around Cumberworth making walking, cycling and driving dangerous. I live on Carr Hill Road and this road is not safe enough for theses HGV to pass with no pavements For the reasons stated above i believe the council should decline the applicant there is not enough benefit to the area for 25 years worth of disruption, noise, dust and pollution
