Our objections are

- detriment to the locality, including not taking into account nearby conservation area;
- too close to residential areas
- inadequate consideration of noise pollution in what appears to be a cursory assessment given the long term nature of the proposal.
- does not appear compatible with net zero targets for the region. Not likely to encourage a transition from car to bike/foot
- significant increase in HGV traffic. Not appropriate given the locality of a first school and the route pupils take to and from the school. Danger also to those taking school buses to middle and high schools nearby.
- I have seen similar quarry vehicles run red lights at the Star and drive wrecklessly including rear axle riding up onto pavement outside Post Office when turning onto Cumberworth Lane.
- increase of slurry and dirt on roads likely to cause accident
- if approved, will trust find be set up for local area to offset the detriment
- toxic gas hazards/ dust / air quality, been adequate assessed.
- no clear benefit to the local area or local job market
- baseline data around
- not in keeping with the rural appeal of the area, including affecting public footpaths and play area (Eunice Lane).
- Allowing for this to continue will place a scar on the locality and will not encourage new residents to the area affecting not just the locality but also the cities round about including Leeds / Huddersfield / Wakefield into which many residents commute, therefore potentially removing prosperity from the area affecting all manner of local businesses.
