I wish to object to this application. As the drivers are paid per journey they will take the shortest route which is up Carr Hill Road, across the busy A629 to Cumberworth Lane and Huddingley Lane to the Victoria crossroads. These narrow roads are frequently used by cyclists, walkers and horse riders and obviously unsuitable for this volume of HGV traffic. Carr Hill Road was recently resurfaced and this volume of HGV traffic will surely cause damage. There is a weight limit in one direction at present which seems to be universally ignored. This project has no benefits to the local residents or to Kirklees. If this project has to go ahead then surely it is common sense for the HGV's to use A roads ie the A635 to New Mill then the A616 to Crow Edge which would be infinitely safer. Is it right that Kirklees should inflict this level of air and noise pollution 11 hours a day for 25 years because it clearly a health hazard.
