The quarry is too close to surrounding villages and houses. Noise, light and environmental pollution and the effect of that on a small village should not be under estimated. Resulting lorries will travel through Upper Cumberworth, adding to already existing problems in the village. Current traffic problems in the village, mostly increasing volume, speed and total lack of consideration of residents using footpaths etc have already been ignored by Kirklees council. Nothing has been done at all - road markings are faded, signage is inadequate and the motorist is given priority over the resident. Several new housing developments nearby in Denby Dale, and next door in Barnsley (Penistone Rise) is already adding more pressure to the link roads. The Sovereign junction remains unaddressed, despite regular accidents and people using residential roads as rat runs to avoid it. The addition of more large wagons to an already straining local infrastructure I have no faith that any serious attempts will be made to manage the new traffic coming from this development.
