I am writing to object to application ref 91280/2023 on the following grounds. This application will have a significant detrimental effect on the quality of life for the residents of Cumberworth, lower Cumberworth and upper Cumberworth. Not only will this quarry have an impact on landscape and character of the area but will cause significant disturbance to residents in the form of noise and dust. These roads already have significant issues with HGVs plus a significant amount of other traffic. This causes severe noise disturbance and various issues with vibrations. There have already been numerous accidents this year at the junctions both at the sovereign and Carr Hill Road. Pedestrians, cyclists, runners and horses regular use Cumberworth Lane and Carr Hill Road for recreational purposes. The increased HGV numbers will be detrimental to the enjoyment of these activities and will impact on highway safety. The highway code states, "When overtaking a pedestrian walking in the road (where there is no pavement)" or when "overtaking horse riders", allow 2 meters of space". This is not practical on the rural roads at Cumberworth where there are no pavements. For the reasons stated above I believe the council should refuse this application.
