I would like to strongly object against planning application 91280/2023. I moved to Cumberworth in 2009 to raise a family in the rural peace and quiet of the countryside. I feel this application would be detrimental in many ways for the community. The noise and dust, and impact on air quality on individual respiratory health that one HGV every 6 minutes, 6 days a week would bring is contrary to the governments and local councils manifestos to reduce co2 emissions and to improve air quality. Since the pandemic, I have noticed an increased amount of individuals using the roads around Cumberworth for recreational purposes. These include walkers, cyclists and horse riders. Activities that are not only good for fitness but also highly beneficial for mental health and wellbeing. Taking into account the highway code which states , “When overtaking a pedestrian walking in the road (where there is no pavement)” or when “overtaking horse riders”, allow 2 meters of space”. This is not practical on the rural roads at Cumberworth where there are no pavements. There are already far too many accidents around the Sovereign and Carr Hill road junction. Additional traffic is likely to acerbate this highway issue. For the reasons stated above I believe the council should refuse this application.
