THIS IS AN OBJECTION AND A COMMENT

None of my original points of my objection from September 2023 have been adequately answered. I refer you to my points in that objection under my name. I also support all the points raised in the Anti Quarry Groups recent submission.

What is very concerning is the deadline for submission. Once again this is set, in my opinion deliberately, for a busy holiday period.

Other individual points of objection are as follows:

1. The traffic assessment includes no account of the existing use of HGV lorries at the other local Quarries. It is the cumulative affect of these together with the new proposal which need to be considered.

2 The traffic route involves a very hazardous turn at the notorious Sovereign crossroads. Many accidents have been reported here and in my expeience Carr Hill Road will still be used as quarry vehicles currently use this route.

3 The transport assessment is factually incorrect with calculations which are also incorrect. Please see the Transport Report as submitted in the Group objection as proof of this.

4 As I stated in my original objection the access road to the quarry is not wide enough. This issue has not been addressed see the reference in the aforementioned Transport Report submitted as part of the Anti Quarry Groups recent submission. The type of vehicle used to transport the clay has changed which only exacerbates the problem.

5 I am concerned that an inadequate Ecology assessment has been made. No reference has been made to the local actually on the site, the birds of prey that nest in the area, the deer or the general abundant wildlife that use the site.

6 Cut and paste issues! The Air Quality Assessment refers to Grantham. Can this report be considered serious as a result?

7 The Phase 2 Geo Enviromental Investigation Report requests an Ecological assessment (page 4). Has this request been met?

8 The Report Limitations page 9 of the Enviromental Investigation Report (carried out when it was dry) render this report of only limited use.

Kirklees Council have failed to respond to a Freedom Of Information request submitted in September. This would lead me to suspect that further information will come to light that will render the Application for quarrying to be rejected on several ground.
