I very much support The Cumberworth Quarry Action Group and their comments but would like to emphasise further my concerns. I notice that the route taken by the hgv's from the site of quarrying to Crows edge now states travelling along Barnsley Road A635 and turning left onto the A629 - it is my experience that hgv's find it difficult to turn left at this junction due to the camber of the road and the steepness of the climb, also this junction is staggered and busy. They therefore prefer to take the route along the unsuitable and already restricted for Hgv's Carr Hill Road. This road already has a restriction on hgv's travelling East along it but it is consistently ignored. It is quite an unusual situation on Carr Hill Road for there to be restrictions only one way, Carr Hill Road is a residential road with no pavement for most of its length. It is heavily used by residents, walkers, cyclists and horse riders etc:- I myself have been touched on the sleeve whilst trying to walk along this road! Since Carr Hill Road was resurfaced the road has got faster and faster and consequently more dangerous. It is not a suitable route for more HGVs, the crossroads at the top of Carr Hill Road has already had numerous accidents, (more than have actually been reported as they were minor) I therefore urge the planning officer to not ignore pleas such as mine, as we are the very people who have to try and live with the consequences.
