I fully agree and wholeheartedly support the comments, objections and questions submitted by the Cumberworth Community Action Group. The impact assessments are lacking in detail and are therefore not an accurate reflection of the impact that this application will bring to this area. The process of the application and timescales set out have not allowed residents to get sufficient access to see if our objections are being considered fully. The transport change, para 2.1.9, to articulated HGVs is totally unsuitable for the road and route proposed. The junction at the Sovereign Garage is very dangerous and has had many accidents. The incline to turn left, travelling away from Upper Cumberworth is particularly treacherous for laden HGVs as they often struggle to get suitable traction. This is a dangerous manoeuvre to filter into the flow of traffic and will also cause accelerated wear and damage to the highway. There is no current and accurate report into the air quality in this area and does not allow me to make an informed decision as to how this application will be detrimental to the air quality. In an area of such natural beauty and wildlife which benefits all who live and enjoy this area, the lack of an ecological report shows a disregard for our community by the applicants.
