Do you wish your comments to be published on the website anonymously?	Yes
I have noted that the travel route is specified as being along the main road to the Sovereign crossroads - a renowned accident site. Kirklees has as a result allowed HGV vehicles to travel UP Carr Hill Road because of how difficult and dangerous this left turn at the Sovereign is. Therefore I would expect that Carr Hill Road will quickly become the default route from the site. The traffic assessment must therefore clearly be inadequate, incomplete and lacks any practical understanding of traffic at that crossroads. HGVs just will not be able to turn left at the Sovereign. I think this route has been proposed because Carr Hill Road is totally unsuitable but if planning is passed will become the default route from the Quarry. It will become a dangerous and deadly road for pedestrians, cyclists, horse riders and motorists alike. As a result I support the Cumberworth Resident Group objection but this is my personal objection.
