Firstly it is imperative you read my previous objections to this planning application some two years ago as most of my previous point have not been considered.
Here we go again!

1 Two weeks to object! I think you will find if you are doing this properly this should be 3 weeks. Par for the course with Kirklees Council.

2 Can you please ensure your website for raising objections works all the time. I tried to use the site on saturday but it was down. Even less time to object. But once again par for the course.

3 One issue that has been considered, the new route. Taking HGV's through the Sovereign crossroads is grossly unsafe and down into New Mill equally so. An accident and fatality just waiting to happen. Please avoid blood on your hands and reroute.

4 A further point on the route is that it runs through Barnsley MBC. Have they been consulted? No accident data has been included? Have West Yorkshire Police been consulted? Where is your impact analysis of the new route? Risk assessments? Too many unanswered questions.

5 The original application refers to an extension of quarrying. This is quite obviously untrue. This is a NEW QUARRY.

6 Please get your vehicle type to be used correct. Time after time inconsistencies occur in your paperwork regarding to the type of HGV used. Size? Number of trips? Inert waste included? Too many inconsistencies and missing facts render the application a hopeless mess.

7 The access road into the quarry should be at least 8.92 meters wide NOT 6 METERS as suggested by Kirklees. No consideration has been given to pedestrians crossing the road on the public footpath that crosses the access road. Where is the risk appraisal?

8 Biodiversity is still not addressed!

9 No updated enviromental reports have been included.

10 No updated ecology reports have been included.

11 I know you don't like referring to the existance of on the site but this needs serious consideration. They live there!

12 Where are councillors Turner and Simpson who promised mitigation action to alleviate the effect on the proposal on the quality of life of local residents.

13 The EIA has not considered the downstream enviromental impact assessment arising from the recent Supreme court judgement. The WHOLE effects, not guesswork or speculation, over all phases of the project should be included. Without this the EIA is invalid, illegal.

In short this application is unsafe. Please take heed.

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
