I wish to strongly object to the proposed development . These comments sit alongside other objections made in relation to the substantive documentation . The latest set of documents do nothing to allay the concerns I have . Despite the proposed re routing information this development if it proceeds creates considerable risk to the public . The use of the A roads including the Sovereign cross roads and New mill road raises considerable concern . There is no risk assessment and the use of a road with considerable existing traffic challenges by introducing 120 round trips of HGVs is unsafe . The 9% gradient means 44 tonne HGVs proceeding down the hill into queuing traffic fully laden . There is a lack of clarity on the size and type of vehicle despite repeated requests and this has huge implications for the modelling and public safety . The environmental issues including noise created has not been addressed , nor has the extent of the Environmental impact Assessment ,which includes no downstream impact of the manufacturing process . This site is home to protected species and there is a duty to protect and preserve that habitat . This proposal remains silent on this . In essence we are digging up green belt to make plant pots . Once lost as an amenity it is lost to generations .
