1. The application is for an extension but surely this must be new quarry working? 2. Whilst the new proposed route shown avoids the use of minor unsuitable roads, the effect of increased - and relatively slow moving at junctions - traffic volume will mean that other traffic is most likely to avoid this route and instead use minor roads. Cumberworth Lane, Heator Lane and Rowgate, Carr Lane and Cross Lane and Carr Hill Road already see increased traffic volumes with accidents often reported at the Cross Lane/Carr Lane/Lane Head Road junction and Carr Hill Road/Cumberworth Lane/Penistone Road junction. The Cumberworth Lane/Barnsley Road/Carr Hill Road junction is particularly busy at school start and finishing times. 3. A significant section of the access to and from the proposed site is along the access road to Bromley Farm Household Waste Recycling Centre which has limited width and is used by members of the public. 4. What proposals are there for the suggested route to be policed and what will be the penalties for noncompliance? 5. What consultation has there been with people/authorities affected by the entire length of the proposed route? 6. There appears to be no benefit shown or proposed at all for the residents of Cumberworth should the application be approved.
